Epilepsy Fellowship from Epilepsy Research Foundation of Japan

The Epilepsy Research Foundation of Japan, founded in 1988, has subsidized many young investigators for the past 20 years. For 2012, the Foundation would like to give two awards to young physicians from Asian countries for training in epileptology in Japan. The fellowship is for a period of 6 months in an epilepsy centre in Japan, within the period from 1st April 2013 to 31st March 2015. The award is 750,000 yen, as stipend for travelling and other expenses. The candidate should be less than 50 years, able to communicate in Japanese or English.

The application should include:

- i. Curriculum vitae with evidences to show the commitment to epilepsy.
- ii. Proposed field and place of study. The subject of study may be clinical or laboratory science. The candidate may also request the Commission to nominate the place of study.
- iii. Letter of recommendation from the national epilepsy leadership.

The candidate should submit the application by 30th of September. Application may be submitted electronically. The results of the application will be informed to the candidate by March 2013.

The Asian Epilepsy Academy (ASEPA) is the educational arm of the Commission for Asian & Oceanian Affairs, International League Against Epilepsy (ILAE). The ASEPA would like to give two awards to young physicians from Asian countries for training in epileptology in selected epilepsy centres in Asian & Oceanian region for 6 months for the year 2012. The award is USD 7,000, as stipend for travelling and other expenses. The candidate should be less than 50 years, able to communicate in English. The applications will be assessed by an evaluating committee.
